Our Success Stories

In the last two years, the Ashburn American Legion Post 2001 has:

- Contributed over \$8,000 in direct support to individual county military veterans needing financial assistance.
- Donated over \$8,000 to veterans' support organizations including Boulder Crest Retreat, Operation Home Front, Operation Vets Haven, and Gold Star Mothers National Monument Foundation.
- Coordinated funding and selection of 37 local High School students to attend the week-long Boys and Girls State program.
- Sponsored the "Ashburn Knights", the Post's American Legion Senior Baseball Team (16-19 year old's). In 2017, the Knights won the District tournament and participated in the Virginia State Legion Baseball Tournament.
