- "Vet Center Community Access Center" is open to serve Veterans, AD military personnel and their families. The VetCen, 751 Miller Drive Suite E, Leesburg, (304-263-6776), is connected to the Department of Veterans Affairs but doesn't report to VA Medical Centers. It provides certified counseling services to help veterans and families with any mental health needs, including PTSD, marriage/family counseling, Military Sexual Trauma, Substance Abuse, Anxiety, and Depression; assists with socioeconomic issues facing the veteran community; and navigating the VA. Vets no longer have to travel to VA Hospital in Martinsburg, WV or Alexandria. Mission focuses on veteran needs, community integration, and first rate counseling tailored to veterans' issues. BoS Chair Randall, Supervisor Buffington, Congresswoman Comstock, Loudoun County Administrator Hemstreet and their staffs were instrumental in establishing the VetCen in Loudoun.
- Coming: **new TRICARE dental and vision plans** administered through the Federal Employees Dental and Vision Insurance Program (FEDVIP). All TRICARE retirees and their families are eligible for both the dental insurance and the vision coverage; active duty military families, only for vision coverage.
