WELCOME BOWLERS TO AMERICAN LEGION POST 327 NORFOLK, VA.

On behalf of American Legion Post 327 Family I want to welcome each Legionnaire, Auxiliary Unit, and SAL Squadron to the American Legion State Bowling Tournament.

The tournament will be held on the 23rd and 24th of Feb 2019 at JEB Little Creek's Gator Bowl. We will bowl the Single and Doubles Events on Saturday the 23th starting with doubles at 9:00am. Singles will start immediately following no later than 1pm. Team Event will be on Sunday the 23rd at 10am. Please factor in some extra travel time, especially on Saturday morning for sign in, due to security measures and ID verification at the gate before being allowed on board the base. You will be using Gate 5, right off the major intersection of Independence Blvd and Shore Drive, to access the base as all other gates are secured on the weekend.

The tournament application can be electronically filled in before printing. If filled in manually, please print very clearly especially on the third page which will be used for base access. Please list anyone in your party, not just bowlers, that will be coming to the bowling alley and do not have base access already, e.g., Retired ID, Active Duty ID, or DOD ID. The tournament fee can be paid by check or money order, please do not send cash with application. Also, I ask that each team bring their yearbook, so we will not have to take a long period of time to verify averages. The cost of bowling will be \$60.00 per person for all events. The breakdown of the price is on the tournament applications.

We have dinner and entertainment planned for both Friday and Saturday nights at Post 327. Make sure you have some cash and luck with you, as there will be raffles held both days at the bowling alley and post for your enjoyment! FYI the bowling alley does not have an ATM machine.

Our Post 327 Family will be hosting two great dinners for you to enjoy! Our Ladies Auxiliary will be hosting a shrimp dinner Friday night, with the SAL Squadron hosting a steak dinner Saturday night. There is a block on the tournament application to let us know how many from your party will be attending each of the dinners, so we can get an accurate head count.

The Legion Post Club is a BYOB establishment, Beer and Wine sold on premises.

**The American Legion Department of Virginia
Tenpin Tournament Rules 2019
USBC Moral Support Certified**

- 1. USBC Rules and Regulations will govern this tournament.**
- 2. Only members in good standing of the American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary and Sons of the American Legion are eligible for this tournament.**
- 3. All prizes will be on a handicap basis. 100% of prize fees will be awarded.**
- 4. There will be a cash prize for at least each ten (10) entries in Team, Single and Doubles. There will be one (1) cash prize awarded for each twenty (20) entries in All Events.**
- 5. All Events is an optional event. To be Eligible for All Events, a fee shall be designated by the Tournament Chairman. Fees must accompany the entry forms.**
- 6. Handicap will be computed on an individual basis of 90% of the difference of the entrant's highest sanctioned average from the previous winter season and scratch of 220 pins. If no sanctioned average from previous winter season, the entrants handicap will be computed on the highest sanctioned average as of January 1st 2019. Entrants having no acceptable entering average under the tournament rules must bowl scratch (210). No summer league averages will be acceptable.**
- 7. Tournament prizes will not be awarded until the averages of all winners in each event has been verified by local association secretary or Local Association Year Book. PLEASE BRING A COPY OF YOUR ASSOCIATION YEAR BOOK.**
- 8. All participants are required to show their USBC and American Legion, American Legion Auxiliary, or Sons of the American Legion Cards.**
- 9. Substitutes must present themselves to the Tournament Director at least one hour before they are scheduled to bowl.**
- 10. Entrants may bowl only once in each event. Bowlers must enter Doubles and Singles, if entered in either.**
- 11. Preference will be given as entries are received and as to distance entrant must travel to and from tournament site. Bowlers residing less than 50 miles from tournament site will be scheduled after those residing farther away. Please designate time preference on your entry form.**
- 12. Official Score: The telescore will be the official score during the game and the official tabulation sheet will then be audited and obvious errors will be corrected. Errors in scoring must be reported within twenty-four (24) hours.**
- 13. All claims for prize money must be made within forty-five (45) days of receipt of prize list or such claims will be disallowed. Such claims must be made to the Tournament Director with a copy going to the Department Bowling Chairman.**
- 14. USBC members are eligible to participate in this tournament, with high score USBC recognition automatically extended to USBC members. Bowlers may sign up for the USBC by paying the current USBC membership fee.**

- 15. Bowler's responsibilities for Average: USBC rule 319a: Bowlers are responsible for verifying his/her own average, whether submitted by the bowler, the team captain or others. If the submitted average is lower than required and results in a lower classification or more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If the submitted average is higher than required, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. In the case of a team of two or more bowlers, the averages will be combined to determine if the correct total is higher or lower than the submitted total. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the bowler's first game of a series. Or, if an extension of time has been granted in writing by tournament management before the end of the first game of a series, the correction can be made within 48 hours after the end of the series.**
- 16. Lanes will be assigned by the Tournament Director, according to entries.**
- 17. All fees must accompany the entry form. All averages must be certified by your league secretary, team captain and bowler. All entries and fees MUST BE RECEIVED BY THE 11th OF FEBRUARY 2019. ENTRIES MUST BE COMPLETELY FILLED OUT.**
- 18. All publications and printed information needed for bowling committee, collection of feeds and entry blanks is responsibility of the tournament director.**
- 19. A complete list of winner and prizes must be submitted to the bowling committee and/or athletic chairman as soon as the tournament is recognized as complete, according to USBC rules and regulations.**
- 20. American Legion bowling tournaments are moral sanctioned events of USBC and any medal or awards rolled in accordance with the awards program of the USBC will be honored.**
- 21. It is expected and requested that each participant give their fullest cooperation to the Tournament Director. Good sportsmanship and good etiquette will help your game and make for a more enjoyable tournament.**
